Yule	Green	Red	White	Winter 
Imbolc	Pale Yellow	White	Silver	St. Bridgit's Cross is associated with fertility. Her festival coincides with Imbolc. 
Ostara	Pale Green	Yellow	Light Orange	Spring 
Beltane	White	Red	Silver	The waxing moon signifies the increasing light and approaching summer. 
Litha	Bright Yellow	Green	Light Green	Summer 
Lughnasadh	Rust Orange	Dark Brown	Green	The sickle is a symbol of the harvest. The blade also resembles the shape of the waning moon. 
Mabon	Maroon	Light Brown	Yellow Ochre	Fall

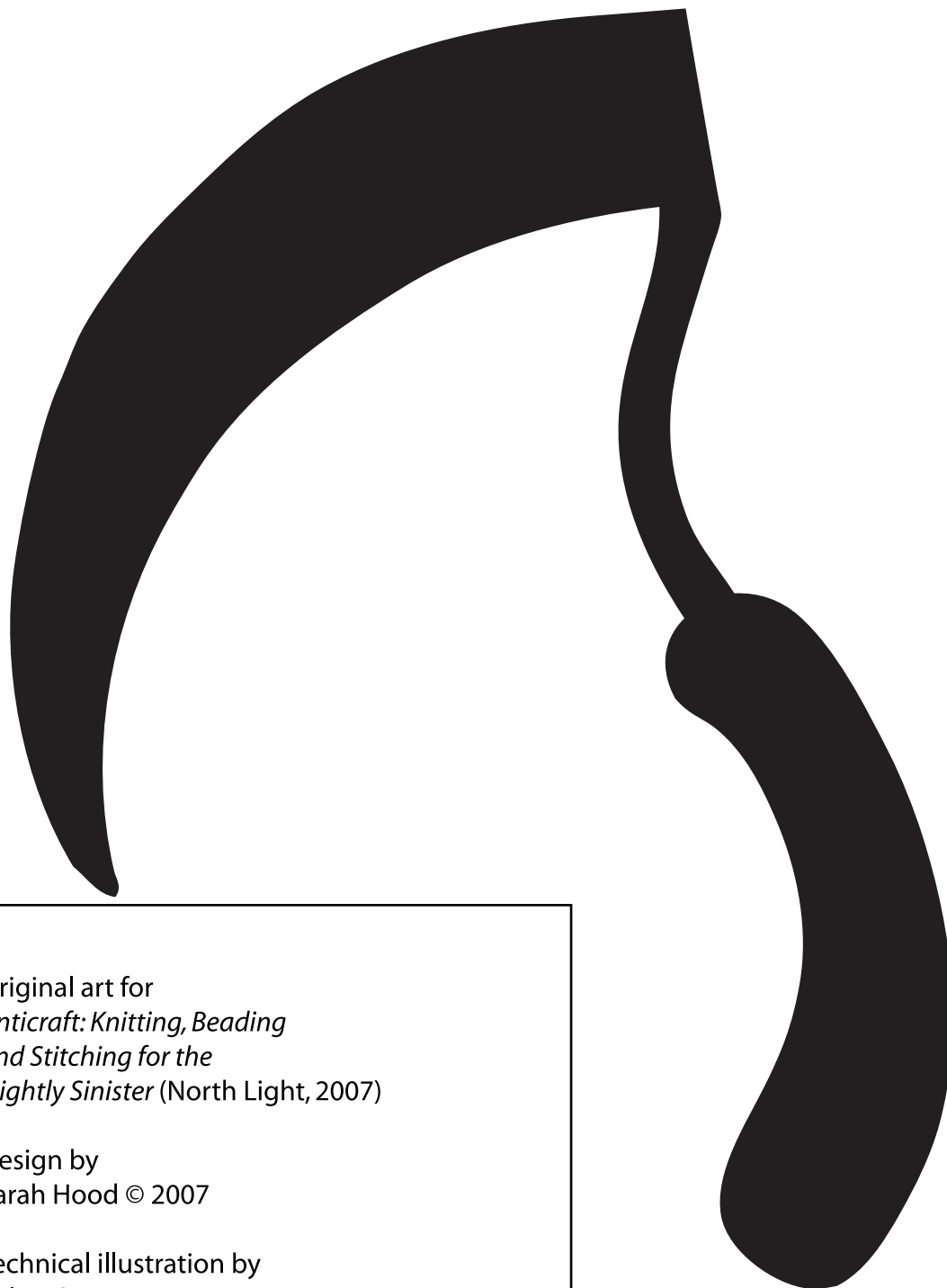

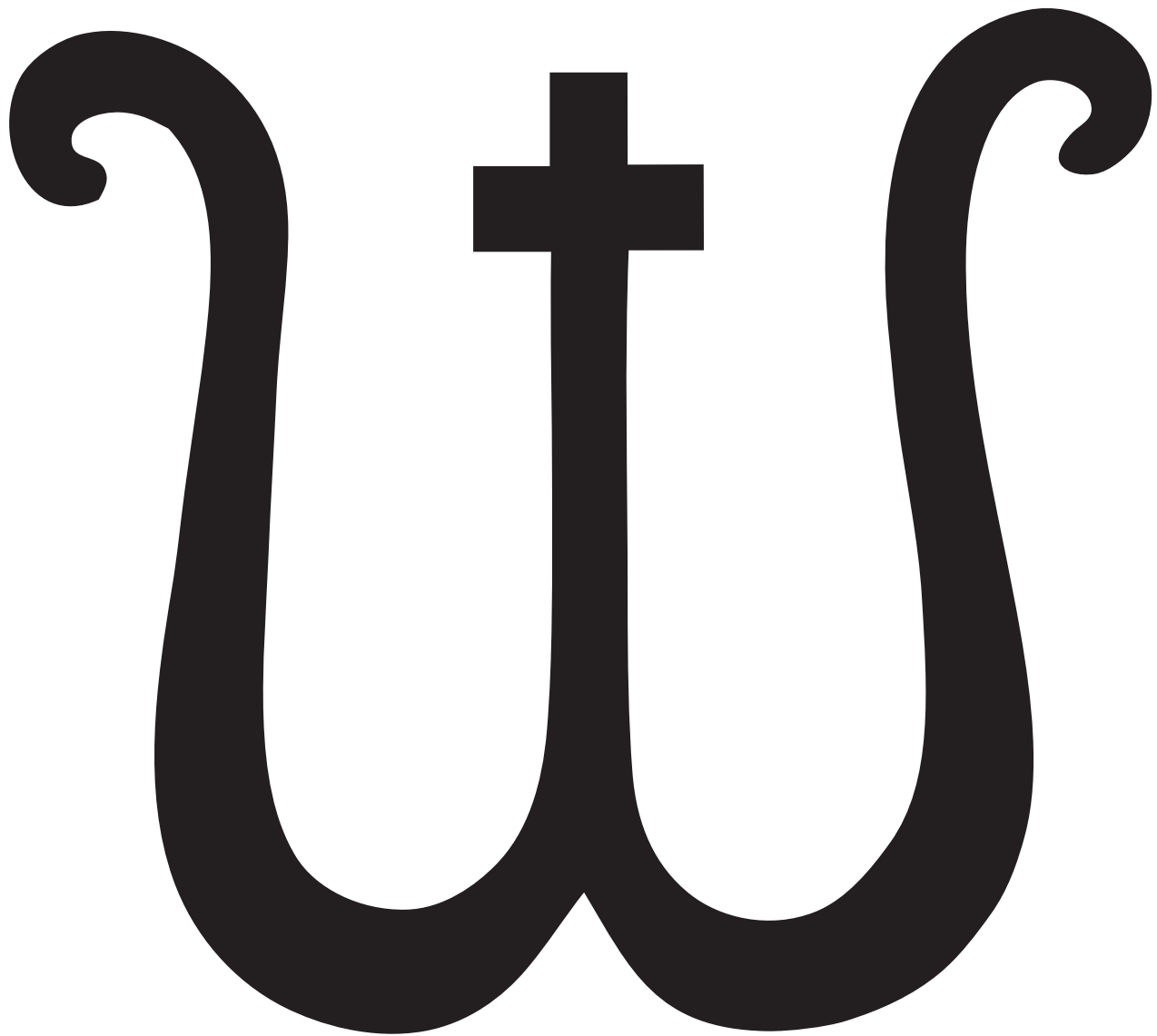
