

# Malice Automagical Measurement Maker

Requires a current version of the free Adobe Reader.

Note to Mac users: Preview will not work; download the free Adobe Reader!

Step 1: Fill in your measurements (in decimal inches).

- A. \_\_\_\_\_ in. (Around natural waist.)  
B. \_\_\_\_\_ in. (From top of shoulder to top of décolletage.)  
C. \_\_\_\_\_ in. (From nipple to nipple.)  
D. \_\_\_\_\_ in. (From natural waist on front, over shoulder, to natural waist on back.)  
E. \_\_\_\_\_ in. (From natural waist to middle of kneecap.)  
F. \_\_\_\_\_ in. (From natural waist on front to top of décolletage.)

Step 2: Your piece sizes will automagically calculate. Now go cut them out!

- #1 Skirt: \_\_\_\_\_ in. Wide by \_\_\_\_\_ in. High.  
#2 Waistband: \_\_\_\_\_ in. Wide by 5in. High.  
#3a & #3b Ties: 32in. Wide by 5in. High.
